A way of defining repeating tracks. (e.g. (1fr) [12], (1fr 2fr) [3], etc.)

-ms-grid-column: <in teg er>

Column Placement (*default: 1*)

-ms-grid-column-span: <in teg er>

Number of columns to span (*default: 1*)

-ms-grid-column-align: <align men t>

Alignment within a column

<align men t> = start | center | end | [stretch]

-ms-grid-row: <in teg er>

Row Placement (*default: 1*)

-ms-grid-row-span: <in teg er>

Number of rows to span (*default: 1*)

Grid Child (old spec) (cont)

-ms-grid-row-align: <align men t>

Alignment within a row

<align men t> = start | center | end | [stretch]

Grid Parent (latest spec)

grid-gap: <gap p> | <gap p:r ow> <gap p:c ol>

Define gap between grid cells. [MDN](#)

Shorthand for **grid-row-gap** and **grid-column-gap**.

grid-row-gap: <gap p>

Define vertical gap between grid cells. [MDN](#)

grid-column-gap: <gap p>

Define horizontal gap between grid cells. [MDN](#)

grid-template-columns: <track -li st>

Define the horizontal (column) template of the grid. [MDN](#)

grid-template-rows: <track -li st>

Define the vertical (row) template of the grid. [MDN](#)

Grid Child (latest spec)

grid-column-start: <in teg er>

Starting column where grid cell should be placed. [MDN](#)

grid-column-end: <in teg er>

Ending column where grid cell should be placed.
