Nouns:	* seven grammatical cases
Grammatical cases	
Nominative case (Nom.):	* "basis" case: is used when the noun is the subject of the sentence – the entity that is doing something
	* does not have any special ending: basic form of the word
Verbs:	* three basic tenses for indicating past, present and future
Present Tense	
	* polish verbs conjugate
	* "He drinks <i>and</i> He is drinking" are translated the same into Polish
Articles	* Polish does not have any articles

Basics 2 - Pronouns and Conjugation

English	Polish
I	ja
you	ty
he	on
she	ona
it	ono
we	my
you	wy
they (only groups of people including a male)	oni
they (all other groups)	one
* verbs conjugate when the pronoun changes	
* <i>ono</i> is rarely used
